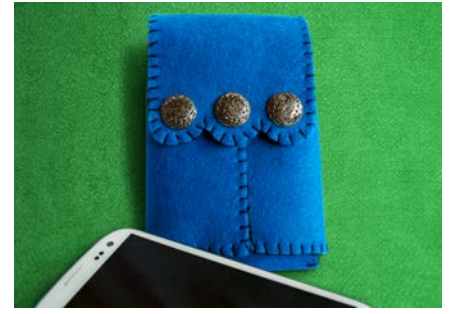




# Folded Phone Case

## Materials

- 1 Kunin CraftCut 9" x 12" ClassicFelt™ in Neon Blue
- 1 Kunin CraftCut 9" x 12" ClassicFelt™ in Baby Blue
- 9" x 12" Lite Steam-A-Seam 2" iron on adhesive
- ½" x 2" hook and loop fastener
- Black #8 pearl cotton thread
- 3 silver buttons – ¾" in diameter

## Tools & Notions

Pins, Scissors, Needles, Iron, Permanent Fabric Glue (I use Fabri Tac Glue or other permanent glue that doesn't seep into the fabric.)

## Notes

*When using the iron-on adhesive, follow manufacturer's directions and use the release paper as a pressing cloth between the felt and the iron. Do not iron directly onto the felt.*

## Instructions

1. Following the manufacturer's directions, iron the adhesive onto the back of one of the pieces of felt. Let cool.
2. Iron the two pieces of felt together with the adhesive between them. Use the release paper from the adhesive as a pressing cloth between the iron and the felt. Do not iron directly on the felt.
3. Pin the pattern in place and cut out the phone case.
4. Fold in the side flaps and overlap them by ½" and pin securely. Blanket-stitch the two flaps together with the black pearl cotton thread.
5. Blanket-stitch around the 2 openings and on the flaps as shown on the pattern piece.
6. Tuck the bottom flap up inside the phone case.
7. Glue the 3 buttons to the scallops of the top front flap of the case. If the buttons have shanks, they can be cut off.
8. Glue a magnetic strip to the back of the flap behind the buttons.
9. Place the phone in the case and fold the flap over the front to determine where to place the final magnetic strip. Glue in place.

### For the Brown Phone Case, use the following materials:

1 Kunin CraftCut 9" x 12" ClassicFelt™ in Cashmere Tan  
1 Kunin CraftCut 9" x 12" ClassicFelt™ in Walnut Brown  
9" x 12" Lite Steam-A-Seam 2 iron-on adhesive  
½" x 4" Magnetic Strip - cut into 2, 2" strips  
Black #8 pearl cotton thread  
1/6 yard hemp trim- 1⅛" wide  
Wooden Button- 1" wide

Tools & Notions: Scissors, Pins, Embroidery Needle, and Permanent Craft Glue

Repeat all of the steps of the directions above until step #7. Glue the natural trim across the front of the flap folding the ends under. Glue the button in the center of the trim. Glue the magnets under the flap and matching on the front of the phone case as above.
