



# Halloween Cat Magnet

## Materials

- 1 Kunin CraftCut 9" x 12" ClassicFelt™ in Orange
- 1 Kunin CraftCut 9" x 12" ClassicFelt™ in Black
- 9" x 12" Lite Steam-A-Seam 2" iron on adhesive
- ½" x 4" Magnetic strip
- Black and orange embroidery floss
- 3" x 6" Purple print fabric
- 4 Contrasting buttons that coordinate with the purple fabric
- 2 Wiggle eyes, 10mm

## Tools & Notions

Pins, Scissors, Needles, Iron, Permanent Fabric Glue (I use Fabri Tac Glue or other permanent glue that doesn't seep into the fabric.)

## Notes

*When using the iron-on adhesive, follow manufacturer's directions and use the release paper as a pressing cloth between the felt and the iron. Do not iron directly onto the felt.*

## Instructions

1. Iron a 6" square piece of iron-on adhesive onto the black felt.
2. Using the pattern pieces, cut out the cat body and the cat head from the black felt in step #1.
3. Iron iron-on adhesive onto the back of the print fabric. Cut 2, 1" x 5 ½" strips of the print fabric.
4. Cut out 2, 4 ½" x 5 ½" pieces of Orange felt.
5. Iron the fabric strips to the front of one piece of Orange felt, top to bottom, ¼" from the outside edges as shown.
6. Position the cat body on the front of the Orange felt over the fabric strips and iron in place. Iron the cat head onto the body at a slight slant.
7. With 3 strands of black embroidery floss, blanket-stitch the edges of the fabric strips.
8. With 3 strands of orange embroidery floss, blanket-stitch around the outside edges of the cat body and head.
9. Stitch a nose and smile onto the cat face. Make a bow of 9" of 3-strand orange embroidery floss and stitch it at the base of the tail with a button in the center. Stitch the other 3 buttons onto the fabric strip on the right side of the banner above and below the cat head as shown.
10. Glue the eyes in place on the cat face. Cut out 2 black eyelids using the pattern piece and glue them in place.
11. Iron the iron-on adhesive onto the back of the remaining 4 ½" x 5 ½" piece of orange felt and then iron the two pieces together for a finished back.
12. With three strands of orange embroidery floss, blanket-stitch around the outside edges of the banner.
13. Glue the magnet strip to the back top of the banner.
