



Halloween Ghost Magnet

Materials

- 1 Kunin CraftCut 9" x 12" ClassicFelt™ in Black
- 1 Kunin CraftCut 9" x 12" ClassicFelt™ in White
- 9" x 12" Lite Steam-A-Seam 2" iron on adhesive
- ½" x 4" Magnetic strip
- Black and orange embroidery floss
- 5" x 5" Orange print fabric
- ½" Orange button
- 2 Wiggle eyes, 10mm

Tools & Notions

Pins, Scissors, Needles, Iron, Permanent Fabric Glue (I use Fabri Tac Glue or other permanent glue that doesn't seep into the fabric.)

Notes

When using the iron-on adhesive, follow manufacturer's directions and use the release paper as a pressing cloth between the felt and the iron. Do not iron directly onto the felt.

Instructions

1. Iron a 6" x 6" piece of iron-on adhesive onto the white felt. Cut out 1 ghost using the pattern piece.
2. Iron a 4" x 5" piece of iron-on adhesive onto the back of the print fabric. Cut out 4, ½" x 4½" strips of print fabric.
3. Cut out 2, 4½" x 6" black pieces of felt.
4. Iron the strips of the fabric onto the front of the black felt as shown.
5. Iron the ghost in place on the front of the black felt over the fabric strips.
6. Sew running stitches along the edges of the fabric strips, top and bottom with 3 strands of black embroidery floss. Stitch a smile on the face of the ghost. Tie a bow in a 9" length of the triple strand floss. Stitch the bow at the neck of the ghost with the orange button in the center.
7. Blanket-stitch around the ghost with 3 strands of orange embroidery floss.
8. Glue the wiggle eyes in place. Cut out 2 white eyelids using the pattern piece and then glue them in place.
9. Iron a 6" x 6" piece of iron-on adhesive onto the remaining 4½" x 6" black felt piece. Iron the front and back of the ghost banner together. Blanket-stitch around the outside edge of the ghost banner with 3 strands of the black embroidery floss.
10. Glue the magnet to the back top of the ghost banner.
