



Rose Wreath

Materials

- 2 yards of 36" wide Kunin ClassicFelt™ in White
- 12" Styrofoam wreath
- 18-20 Pink glass pearl beads, 8mm

Tools & Notions

Pins, Scissors, Permanent Fabric Glue (I use Fabri Tac Glue or other permanent glue that doesn't seep into the fabric.)

Instructions

1. Using the patterns provided, cut out 50 of the large oval and 20 of the small oval, keeping the different sizes separate.
2. Cut the spiral cuts in each oval. They can vary slightly for more interesting roses.
3. Starting with the inside of the spiral, roll the felt strip to create the rose. When you reach the end of the strip, glue the center over the back of the rose to secure all of the wraps.
4. Glue the large roses side by side to the front center of the wreath as it is facing you, 18-20 roses.
5. Glue the large roses around the outside center of the wreath side by side to cover the outside of the wreath form allowing the roses to fill in any open spaces, 24-30 roses.
6. Glue the small roses around the inside center of the wreath side by side to cover the Styrofoam form, 18-20 roses.
7. Glue beads into the center of each rose on the front of the wreath.
8. Cut a ½" x 4" strip of white felt. Form it into a loop with the ends slightly overlapping and glue the loop to the back of the wreath for a hangar.
