



Spider Pillow

Materials

- 2 Kunin CraftCut 9" x 12" ClassicFelt™ in Black
- ½ yard Kunin Spiderweb SeasonalFelt™
- 1 package black ric-rac trim
- 2 wiggle eyes, ½"
- 3 white chenille stems/pipe cleaners
- 8oz polyester stuffing

Tools & Notions

Pins, Needle, Scissors, Sewing Machine, Black or Park Purple Thread, Permanent Fabric Glue (I use Fabri Tac Glue or other permanent glue that doesn't seep into the fabric.)

Instructions

1. Cut two spider pillow pieces. Cut six ¼" x 9" black strips.
2. Glue black strips from center extending 1" beyond each pillow point. *Figure A*
3. Position the ricrac 1" from edge beginning at a black strip glue around the pillow joining ends and cut. Repeat with second row.
4. Cut a 2" circle at center of spider pillow front.
5. With wrong sides of spider pillow pieces together topstitch 1/2" from edge completely around pillow.
6. Stuff pillow through center opening pushing stuffing into points first. Sew opening shut.
7. Cut out two spider pieces. Cut out one 2" circle. Cut chenille stems/pipe cleaners in half.
8. With spider pieces together topstitch.
9. Stuff spider. Glue circle over spider opening. Glue eyes onto center front of spider.
10. Bend chenille stem legs into accordion shape. Make three tiny holes each on opposite edges of spider back. Glue ends of legs into holes. *Figure B*
11. Bring needle from back of pillow through to center front and through back of spider, take stitch back down through spider and pillow. Pull thread tight to indent spider into pillow and tie ends securely.

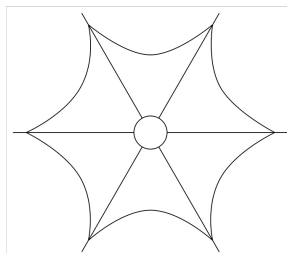
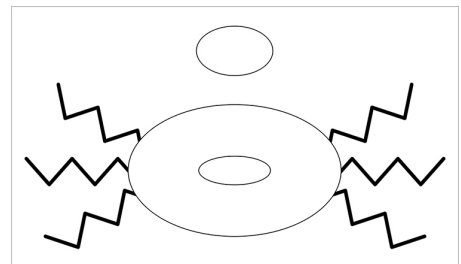
