



Standing Snowman

Materials

- 2 Kunin CraftCut 9" x 12" ClassicFelt™ in White
- 1 Kunin CraftCut 9" x 12" ClassicFelt™ in Neon Blue
- 1 Kunin CraftCut 9" x 12" ClassicFelt™ in Orange
- 3 Buttons to match the Neon Blue felt, ½"
- 5 Black pom-poms, 5mm
- White embroidery floss
- 2 Wiggle eyes, 10mm
- Fiberfil

Tools & Notions

Pins, Scissors, Needles, Permanent Fabric Glue (I use Fabri Tac Glue or other permanent glue that doesn't seep into the fabric.)

Instructions

1. Using the patterns, cut out 2 white body, 2 white arms, and 1 white bottom.
2. Blanket-stitch the body pieces together with 3 strands of white embroidery floss from bottom left to bottom right. Leave the flat bottom open.
3. Stuff the body with Fiberfil so it is full but not overly stuffed.
4. Pin the bottom felt piece to the open bottom of the snowman and blanket-stitch the bottom closed. Now the snowman will stand.
5. Blanket-stitch around the arms leaving the top 1" open when thumbs are up. Slightly stuff the hands and the arms. Do not stuff the center 2" of the arm piece. Finish stitching the arms shut.
6. Glue the center of the arms to the center back just under the neck. With the white thread, stitch the shoulders of the arms to the body. Stitch the underarms to the body as well.
7. Cut a 1" x 12" strip of Neon Blue felt. Cut 5, horizontal ¾" slits in each end of the strip for the tails of a scarf. Tie the scarf around the neck of the snowman and spot glue as necessary.
8. Glue 3 buttons down the front of the snowman evenly.
9. Cut out 1 Orange nose using the pattern.
10. Glue the orange nose to the center of the face. Glue 5, 5mm black pom-poms to the face for a smile. Glue the wiggle eyes just above the nose to the face.
11. Cut a 2½" x 6" strip of Neon Blue. Glue it into a tube, by overlapping and gluing the ends by ¼".
12. Fold ¼" of one edge up of the tube for a hat brim. Glue the tube with the folded edge facing front to the top of the head of the snowman slightly hiding the eyes.
13. Gather the open edge of the scarf ½" from the end and tie with white thread.
