



# Tooth Fairy Pillow

## Materials

- 2 Kunin CraftCut 9" x 12" ClassicFelt™ in Peacock
- 1 Kunin CraftCut 9" x 12" ClassicFelt™ in Red
- 1 Kunin CraftCut 9" x 12" ClassicFelt™ in White
- 1 Kunin CraftCut 9" x 12" ClassicFelt™ in Black
- ½ yard of 1" ric-rac trim
- 2 Wiggle eyes, 10mm
- White embroidery floss
- Fiberfil

## Instructions

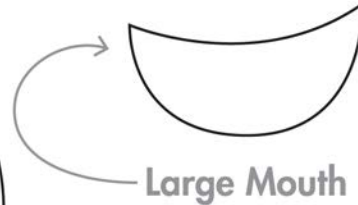
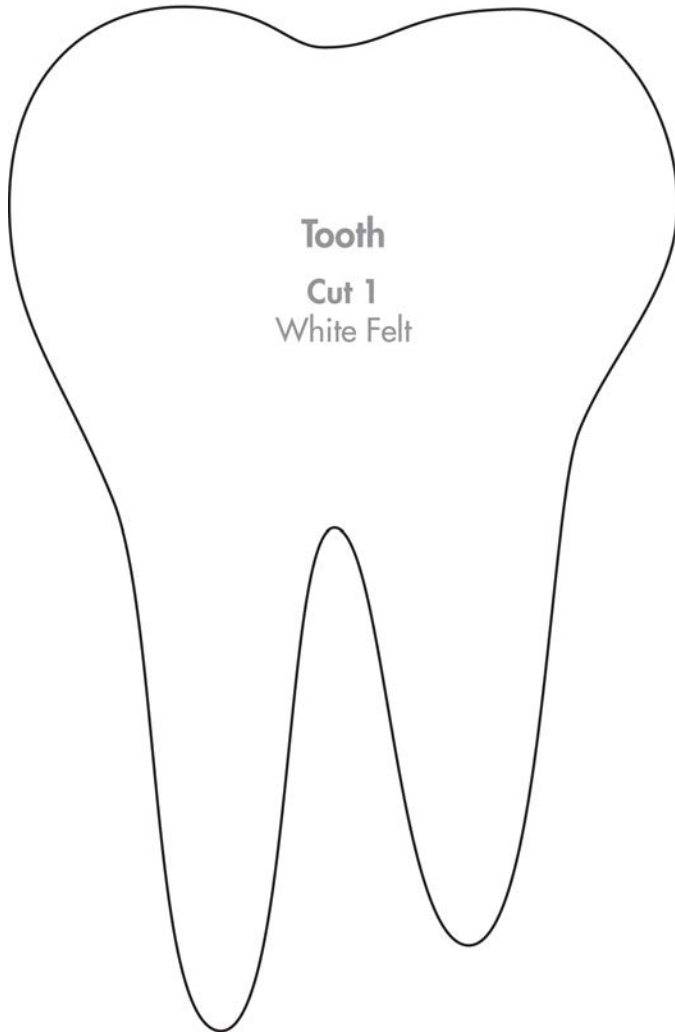
1. Cut out 2, 9" squares of peacock felt for the pillow form, 1 white felt tooth, 2 white felt eyelids, 1 black large mouth and 1 red small mouth.
2. Pin the tooth into the center of one 9" square.
3. Blanket-stitch around the sides and bottom of the tooth with 3 strands of white embroidery floss. Leave the top open to insert money from the tooth fairy.
4. Glue the ric-rac down the sides of the pillow front on either side of the tooth, 1" away from the tooth. Let dry. Trim off excess trim.
5. Pin the pillow front and back together with the tooth on the inside of the pillow. Stitch a ¼" seam allowance all around the pillow, leaving 2" open at the bottom center.
6. Gently flip the pillow inside out and finger press the corners and seams into shape.
7. Stuff the pillow with Fiberfil and then hand-stitch the opening shut.
8. Glue the eyes to the face of the tooth. Glue the eyelids in place.
9. Glue the black mouth in place and glue the red mouth in place.

## Tools & Notions

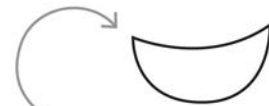
Pins, Scissors, Needles, Sewing Machine, Permanent Fabric Glue (I use Fabri Tac Glue or other permanent glue that doesn't seep into the fabric.)

Actual Size

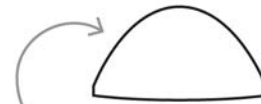


Cut 1
