



# Travel Tissue Cover

## Materials

- 1 Kunin CraftCut 9" x 12" ClassicFelt™ in Black
- Print Fabric 9" x 12" in red or burgundy
- 9" x 12" Lite Steam-A-Seam 2" iron on adhesive
- 1/3" yard burgundy braid trim to match fabric
- Black #8 pearl cotton thread
- 1/2" x 4" magnetic strip

## Instructions

1. Iron the iron-on adhesive to the wrong side of the fabric.
2. Iron the fabric onto the felt.
3. Cut out the pattern piece, pin it to the fabric/felt piece and cut out.
4. Fold the piece with felt pieces together and stitch 1/4" seam allowance from X to X on the sewing machine.
5. Carefully flip it inside out and form the corners.
6. Backstitch around the opening and the flap with the pearl cotton.
7. Carefully glue the braid on the felt side of the flap for embellishment. You need to carefully glue the ends and let dry. Trim away any excess.
8. Cut the magnetic strip in half for 2, 2" lengths. Glue one on the inside of the flap and the other to the front of the pocket being sure to line them up.

## Tools & Notions

Pins, Scissors, Needles, Iron, Sewing Machine, Permanent Fabric Glue (I use Fabri Tac Glue or other permanent glue that doesn't seep into the fabric.)

## Notes

*When using the iron-on adhesive, follow manufacturer's directions and use the release paper as a pressing cloth between the felt and the iron. Do not iron directly onto the felt.*
