



Crow Throw Pillow

Materials

- 3 Kunin CraftCut 9" x 12" ClassicFelt™ in Black
- 1 Kunin CraftCut 9" x 12" ClassicFelt™ in Gold
- 1 Kunin CraftCut 9" x 12" ClassicFelt™ in Orange
- 1 Kunin CraftCut 9" x 12" ClassicFelt™ in Orchid
- 1 Kunin CraftCut 9" x 12" ClassicFelt™ in Bright Lilac
- 16 black buttons, 3/8"
- 4 black buttons 1"
- 8oz polyester stuffing

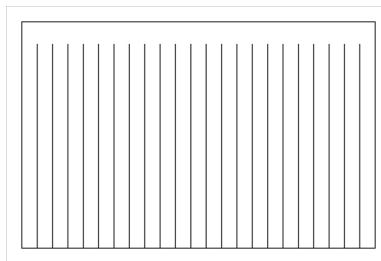
Instructions

1. Cut two 2½" by 12" strips from black. Overlap ½" and glue to opposite sides of Violet Sky piece. Glue a full piece of black felt lengthwise along opposite ends. *Figure A*
2. Cut crow, pumpkin and three leaves. Glue pumpkin to Violet Sky piece. Glue on leaves. With black craft thread outline stitch pumpkin and vines through leaves. Glue crow on top of pumpkin.
3. Glue or sew buttons evenly spaced along Violet Sky edge.
4. Fold opposite ends of pillow over to overlap ½". Finger press folds. Glue side seams.
5. Stuff pillow through center back opening pushing stuffing into corners first. Sew or glue opening shut.
6. To make tassels, cut purple felt into four equal strips 3" by 9". Cut narrow strips stopping ½" from top of each strip along entire length of each piece. *Figure B*
7. Roll the top of strip tightly into a cylinder gluing ends. Wrap 3/8" from top with craft thread, tie. Glue button to top of tassel. Glue each tassel to a pillow corner.

Tools & Notions

Pins, Needle, Scissors, Sewing Machine, Black Embroidery Floss, Permanent Fabric Glue (I use Fabri Tac Glue or other permanent glue that doesn't seep into the fabric.)
