



Festive Crown

Materials

- 1 Kunin CraftCut 9" x 12" in any color or style
- Embellishments of your choice (Ideas: buttons, beads, rhinestones, ribbon)

Tools & Notions

Scissors, Pins, Thread (if using sew-on embellishments), Permanent Fabric Glue (I use Fabri Tac Glue or other permanent glue that doesn't seep into the fabric.)

Instructions

1. Print pattern.
2. Cut crown piece from felt.
3. Glue crown $\frac{1}{4}$ " in from one edge and second piece of felt
4. Cut around entire crown $\frac{1}{4}$ " larger.
5. Cut from main felt piece a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12" strip for back of crown.
6. Glue one end of strip to crown end.
7. Pin opposite sides together.
8. Try on head and trim off excess (If you need to add extra cut first strip to half needed.)
9. Embellish crown before gluing ends together. It is easier to decorate while it is laying flat. If your crown is heavily embellished you made need support for the center peak, add a small strip of felt cut from a scrap and glue to the center back of peak.
