



Fall Wall Hanging

Materials

- 1 Kunin CraftCut 9" x 12" ClassicFelt™ in Antique White
- 1 Kunin CraftCut 9" x 12" ClassicFelt™ in Goldenrod
- 1 Kunin CraftCut 9" x 12" ClassicFelt™ in Olive
- 1 Kunin CraftCut 9" x 12" ClassicFelt™ in Walnut Brown
- 1 Kunin CraftCut 9" x 12" ClassicFelt™ in Copper Canyon
- 1 Kunin CraftCut 9" x 12" ClassicFelt™ in Ruby
- 1 pumpkin-colored button, 1"
- 8 buttons in various fall shades, 3/8"
- 1 dowel, 12"

Instructions

1. Cut 4" by 9" from Copper Canyon for top border, four bottom tab pieces, 1 leaf. Cut from Goldenrod two leaves, four bottom tabs. Cut from Ruby two leaves, two bottom tab pieces. Cut from Olive pitcher and handle.
2. Fold top border in half. Use craft thread to stitch to top of Antique White piece. Straight stitch border along bottom of Antique White piece.
3. Glue vase to Antique White piece. Glue handle. Straight stitch with craft thread through pitcher handle and across pitcher bottom.
4. Pair up bottom tabs and straight stitch with craft thread around each one. Sew button to center of each one. Glue to bottom back edge of Antique White piece.
5. Glue leaves to another color of remaining felt pieces. Cut around 1/8" larger to make a border around each leaf. Straight stitch with craft thread veins of the leaves. Stitch across bottom of leaf pulling stitches slightly to shape leaf.
6. Glue leaves to pitcher. Straight stitch sprigs behind leaves and add buttons. Glue large button to center of leaves. Insert dowel to hang.

Tools & Notions

Pins, Needle, Scissors, Sewing Machine, Pumpkin-colored Embroidery Floss, Permanent Fabric Glue (I use Fabri Tac Glue or other permanent glue that doesn't seep into the fabric.)
